## **THE DISH: Restaurants introduce summer specials, cocktails**

Wolfgang Puck restaurants are offering special pricing this summer. Locals can get 25 percent off their checks from June 1 through Sept. 30 at Cut at Palazzo, Spago and Chinois at The Forum Shops at Caesars, Postrio at the Grand Canal Shoppes and Trattoria del Lupo at Mandalay Bay.
